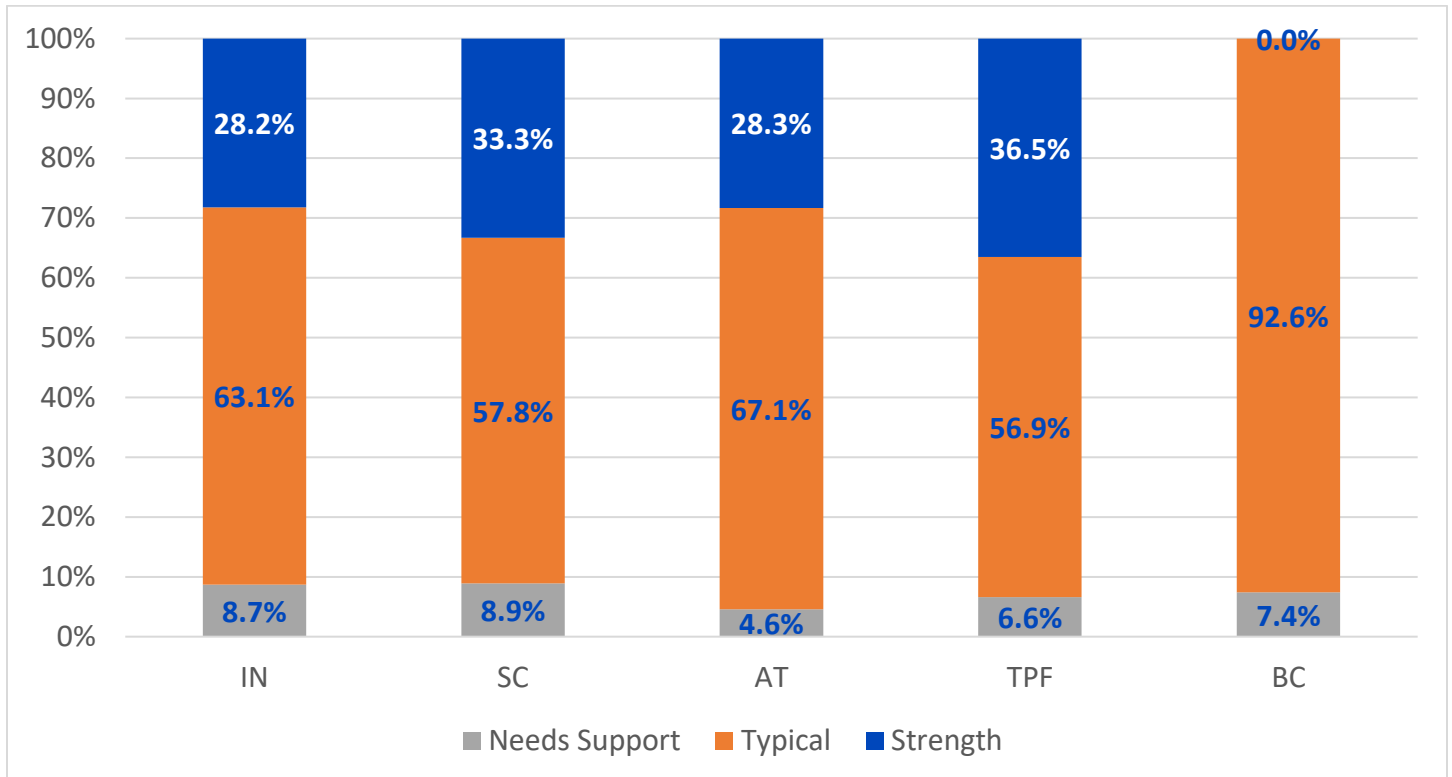

Total Protective Factors (TPF)

- **Initiative (IN):** The child's ability to use independent thought and action to meet his/her needs.
- **Self-Control (SC):** The child's ability to experience a range of feelings and express them using words and actions that society considers appropriate
- **Attachment (AT):** The mutual, strong and long-lasting relationship between a child and significant adults, such as parents, family members, and teachers

Behavioral Concerns (BC)

- **Attention Problems:** Difficulties a child may have in focusing on a task and ignoring competing environmental stimuli
- **Aggression:** Hostile and destructive acts directed at other persons or things
- **Emotional Control Problems:** Difficulties a child has in modifying the overt expression of negative emotions
- **Withdrawal/Depression:** Behaviors related to emotional and social withdrawal in which the child is self-absorbed and often attends to his or her own thoughts or play rather than engaging in reciprocal interactions
