

Total Protective Factors (TPF)

- Initiative (IN): The child's ability to use independent thought and action to meet his/her needs.
- Self-Control (SC): The child's ability to experience a range of feelings and express them using words and actions
 that society considers appropriate
- Attachment (AT): The mutual, strong and long-lasting relationship between a child and significant adults, such as
 parents, family members, and teachers

Behavioral Concerns (BC)

- Attention Problems: Difficulties a child may have in focusing on a task and ignoring competing environmental stimuli Aggression: Hostile and destructive acts directed at other persons or things
- · Emotional Control Problems: Difficulties a child has in modifying the overt expression of negative emotions
- Withdrawal/Depression: Behaviors related to emotional and social withdrawal in which the child is selfabsorbed and often attends to his or her own thoughts or play rather than engaging in reciprocal interactions
