## Feedback from FAC Members

- All seems to be logical and makes sense, thoughtful flow
- Assumption- We will be in a more stable political climate; Agree with the continued community involvement; argue that
  we revisit the 2016 referendum and show what we accomplished from that and what was left on the table; transparency
  inspires me to act
- Has the board found if a spring or fall election has been more favorable; point out that we did good work with the 2016 referendum- this is what we did and what we wish we could have done?
- Another vote for what was accomplished; wisely spent money and stay within budget

Of Note, Successful for either election (spring or fall); Referendum is more of a norm now

- Assumption that community members have knowledge of previous referendums
- Agree with postponing 2021 Referendum to 2022
- Assumption that people are going to be crabby pants; Agree with the timeline because people are tight wound

- Finishing off 2020
- Two noteworthy retirements
- Still work done over break daily tasks and larger items
- District Office Admin Jim's example
- HS/MS Principals Registration, Staffing, Semester 2\*
- COVID updates
  - Daryl (40 years) and Shelly Tiesty (44 years) Bus drive for student transit
  - Made decision to go back to hybrid; plenty of work to do with daily tasks and larger items
  - Jim Schmitt working on Summer school (180 different positions hired for summer school)- hiring, program details, handout
  - Principals- If you are a fifth-grade parent, high school or middle school parent- should be getting materials soon; Every
    January this is being planned out
    - Semester 2- Lots of heavy lifting by the principals at the secondary level, staff at district office, etc- More students wanting to switch models
  - COVID updates
    - Nice to get back to students in the hybrid model
    - Data shown with staff absences- very happy with
    - Continue to monitor data each day
    - New strain of COVID coming out- doesn't make you feel good; Vaccines coming out though
      - Prevea shares a weekly updates- medical data for the state, county, etc.
  - Kim conversation with County Health Dept
    - o Major providers have received the vaccine; EC County ready to move to next stage
    - Mass vaccination clinic at North High School- on Wednesday for next several months; Stage 3 is where teachers and school staff will be able to receive vaccine

- Michael- Prevea meetings- Dr said that he was getting the vaccine that day; he has done his research on it and he was excited to get it- About 40% of the population will have a side effect- side effects are positive as it shows your body is working how it is supposed to;
  - o There will be a rotation so that staff will not be missing due to side effects all at the same time
  - o February will go more in depth into COVID and what things may look like

Silver linings from having all the changes during COVID; behavioral issues, testing

Question regarding data from the most recent survey; Michael will follow up on this Engineering PLT W project- Is that starting back up and how are families being notified

Classes students haven't been able to take because they weren't offered

Question- Staff concern- regarding the lack of intervention for the striving students- how is the district approaching helping students who are falling behind in elementary

- Provide additional time for staff to interventionist to take place; schools are asking staff to do this Key Club at North- Had a lot of students volunteering to work with elementary students but weren't able to do it- provide via zoom?
  - Working on creating this to connect the high school students and elementary students
