2. TOPIC OF EVENING: Elementary & Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III)

- a. ESSER III Stakeholder Input Presentation Superintendent Johnson
 - i. Overview ESSER III: One-time funds (12.8 million dollars) to support the response to COVID 19 Pandemic from March of 2020 through September of 2024
 - ii. Possible Use for Funds: learning loss (20 percent must be used this way), preparedness and response, addressing long term school closure, outreach and services for special populations, mental health services and supports, and education technology
 - iii. Proposed Priorities for Addressing Learning Loss: instructional coaching, interventionists at all levels, student support positions, staff development, and summer school/extended day opportunities
 - iv. Proposed Priorities for Other Needs: mental health concerns, behavioral concerns, family support, technology, and PPE/Safety
 - v. Our Plan for Safe Return: ensure continuity of services

 - i. Reviewed Survey Responses
 1. Suggestions:
 - a. Consider additional data collection methods
 - b. Be mindful that funds are time-limited
 - c. Partner with the community (UWEC, Mental Health Agencies, Pablo Center)
