

Career and Technical Education Nondiscrimination

The Eau Claire Area School District offers career and technical education programs in Agriculture and Natural Resources; Architecture and Construction; Business, Marketing, and Information Technology; Education and Training; Graphic Design; Family and Consumer Sciences; Finance; Health Science; Hospitality and Tourism; Manufacturing; and Science Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. Admission to these programs is based on enrollment and seat availability.

It is the policy of the Eau Claire Area School District not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex or handicap in its vocational programs, services, or activities as required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

Additionally, the Eau Claire Area School District will take steps to assure that lack of English language skills will not be a barrier to admission and participation in all educational and vocational programs.
