Weekend Kids Meals



The purpose of the program is to provide food for your child for the weekend when school meals are not available. This program is offered by Feed My People Food Bank. This is open to all students and the food is at no cost to you or your child. There are no income guidelines or requirements. Any student is welcome to participate and is free to withdraw from the program at any time. will receive a meal bag every week with enough food for breakfast and lunch for him/her for Saturday and Sunday, plus snacks. **Please be aware that peanut products are often distributed so children with food allergies should not be enrolled.**

Rental Assistance

Applications are now being accepted for The Wisconsin Rental Assistance Program (WRAP). This program offers eligible households experiencing income loss due to the COVID-19 pandemic up to \$3,000 in rental payment and/or security deposits. Eligibility

Applicants must be an adult Wisconsin resident with a household income at or below 80% of the county median income in the month of or prior to the application date. If all adults in the household are ineligible non-citizens, a child or minor head-of-household with a Social Security Number (SSN) may apply.
