## Community Food and Other Resources

### ECASD MEALS

- ECASD will be providing free breakfast and lunch to students on what would have been regularly scheduled school days while schools are closed. (No breakfast or lunch will be offered during the week of Spring Break – March 23 through March 27).
- Free breakfast and lunch can be picked up at the following locations: Delong, Northstar and South, Tuesday, starting March 30th from 11:30 am. and 1:00 pm.
- Pick up locations will be outside the middle schools and will be served in a “grab and go” fashion.
- Meals will include lunch for the current day and breakfast for the following day. All meals will be free regardless of current eligibility status or location of enrollment.
- **Students do not need to be present to pick up the school meals.**

### WEEKEND KIDS MEALS

- Feed My People will be delivering weekend kids meals to the middle schools on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Those food items will be handed out during the school meal distribution time (11:30am - 1:00pm) to any student who would like one.
