## What text number will the messages come from?

The District and school text messages all come from an ambiguous 6-digit number. Please consider saving this number as the contact for our ParentSquare account. This number might change but would only be from the following four.

Current text Number for the District and all schools is **66458**

Others if it changes (consider saving these for the same contact): 60710, 87366, 36794

## What will the text message look like?

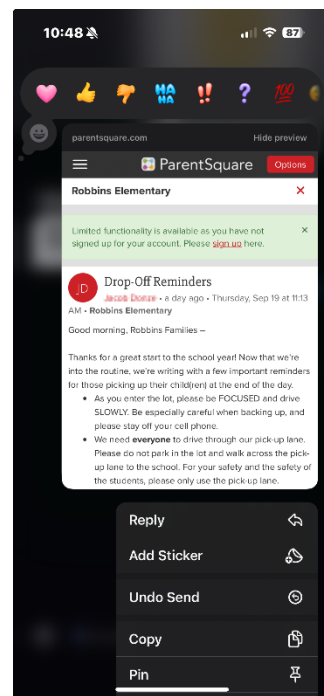

## How do I test if the link is safe, or not, if I have suspicions?

On your phone, press and hold down on the link, and a preview will show where the link is going to, in a safe way. To the right is how the previews look on an iPhone.
