A student may be considered homeless if they are not in stable or adequate housing and their <u>primary</u> residence is:

- At another person's residence due to loss of housing, economic hardship or related circumstance
- In an emergency or transitional shelter
- In a motel, hotel, seasonal trailer park, or campground
- Separate from legal parents or guardians
- In a car, park, public space, abandoned building, substandard housing, bus or train station, or a similar setting

All students identified as living in a homeless situation have the right to:

- Immediate enrollment in school, even when records are not present at time of enrollment
- Continue attending the school of origin (school attended when student became homeless)
- Receive transportation assistance to the school of origin (if student is living outside of school's boundaries)
- Support for academic success
- Free school meals
- Assistance acquiring items needed for school
- Support accessing community resources for family and/or student.
