





Tens Go Fish!



How To Play:

Remove the Jack, Queen, and King.

Each player gets 5 cards. Players match up cards to make sums of ten. Players take turns asking each other for the missing addend needed to make ten. If player 2 does not have the card, player I will "go fish" in the pile of cards in the middle. When a player gets a match, he or she draws another card. If a player runs out of cards, he or she draws two from the pile. The player with the most matches wins.

How To Play:

Pemove the 10, Jack, Queen, and King.

Place cards in rows. Players take turns

flipping two cards to make a sum of

ten. If the sum is ten, the player gets

to keep the cards. If not, the cards are

flipped face down and the second

player gets a chance to find a match

that makes ten. The winner is the player

with the most cards after all cards have

been matched.
