1. Students should have read chapters I-VIII of Narrative of the Life of a Slave by Frederick Douglass and completed the pre-reading activity. I have posted a video lecture of the pre-reading activity and an analysis of chapter I <https://youtu.be/6wXcW-r-DP4> students may also access this in Canvas.
2. This week, I have asked students to complete a partner analysis (no more than three per group) of a self selected chapter I-VIII. Students can share a document or facetime, video chat and assign one person to write the analysis. Please share with me in Google Docs or email to cschroeder@ecasd.us by Thursday, April 9th. I have an example analysis in Canvas for guidance.
3. Students should also read chapters IX and X for Tuesday, April 14th.
4. Ms. Corning sent an email update about AP testing. Please let me know if you did not receive it. There are directions about how to take your test. I do have some opportunities for review on Canvas (these are optional and for enrichment only)
5. I am still accepting essays (Merchant of Venice Synthesis) that were due Friday March 30th.
