The Nature of the Award:

The total amount of the award is \$4,000, applied to your UWSP tuition each semester in the amounts of \$200 the Freshman year, \$400 the Sophomore year, \$600 the Junior year, and \$800 the Senior year.

Criteria for selection:

- o You declare chemistry or biochemistry as your major at UWSP
- o You have received at least a 3.50 GPA in high school
- You have a demonstrated capacity and potential for excellence in the field of chemistry or biochemistry

To apply:

- 1. Complete all sections of the Student Application Form
- 2. Arrange to have a letter of recommendation submitted on your behalf by your high school chemistry or science teacher
- 3. Have your high school counselor submit the High School Recommendation Form *and* your high school transcripts
