PARKING PERMITS

Parking permits are available for purchase from the business office beginning Friday, September 1st from 7:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. The permit's non-refundable cost for the school year is \$50, Please bring your completed application, driver's license, cash, or check made out to MHS, and slip from library indicating you have no library fines. Applications are available in the office areas or by clicking HERE. All cars parked in the lot need parking permits on display starting September 18th.

Student Drop Off and Pick Up

If you transport your student to and/or from school, Doors #1 and 2 via the Clairemont Parking lot, Doors #4 and #6 off Keith Street, as well as Door #15 on the east side of the building are all available for student access. Given traffic delays, especially in the morning, taking advantage of all of these drop-off points might alleviate the issue.

Obtaining a Work Permit - Changes

The Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division has developed a new online work permit application tool. The online application is available to the parents of minors 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from any computer, tablet, smartphone, or similar device. The application is live now. A parent can access the site <u>using these instructions</u>. Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit card or an AHC direct withdrawal. Once the permit application process is complete, the Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer.

Work permits cannot be obtained at Memorial High School. You must use the online system described above.

Free and Reduced Meals

The Clothing Closet needs Memorial Wear. Looking for recent or retro! Drop off at door 15.



What do I need to prepare? If you are interested in a lead or supporting role, prepare a 1-2 minute Broadway or Disney song (such as a verse and a chorus) to sing for Mrs. K. with a karaoke track. If you are interested only in an ensemble role, you do not need to prepare ahead of time. All students will learn a short dance and song at the auditions. Those interested in lead/supporting roles will also read from the script.
