The National Prescription Drug Take-Back event is hosted by the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and is coordinated locally by the Eau Claire County Sheriff's Office, Altoona Police Department, Marshfield Clinic Health System, Village of Fall Creek Police Department, Eau Claire City-County Health Department, and the Eau Claire Health Alliance - Substance Misuse Action Team.

National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day

Unused or expired medications should never be flushed, poured down the drain, or tossed in the garbage. Safely dispose of prescription medicine, over-the-counter medications, ointments, patches, creams, non-aerosol sprays, vials, and pet medications at a Prescription Drug Take-Back event on Saturday, October 28th from 10a.m. to 2p.m.!

Submit your senior photo TODAY. Photos are due by November 1st. You can find the upload link by following the YEARBOOK link on the Memorial website home page, or by using the QR codes that are on posters around the school.

Your picture must meet the following criteria:

-Head and shoulder portrait (upright) vs. a landscape image (sideways) picture. If the picture you submit is not cropped to head and shoulders, we will crop it for you.

-Minimum resolution of 300 dpi and size of 2 inches x 3 inches. You may submit an uncropped, full-size

version, and we will crop it for you. Please do not send pictures from a social media site such

as *Instagram* or *Facebook*. These tend to be low resolution images which will print blurry. Please send the original digital version **saved as a .jpeg.**

-The **picture does not** depict violence, alcohol, drugs, or anything that would violate school rules such as a weapon.

-Pictures may be uploaded via the Jostens Senior Picture Submission link For your peace of mind, if we don't have your picture, a letter will be mailed home after the deadline. If you receive a letter or aren't shown on the list, please email a picture to Ms. Campbell de Loyo by December 1. A list of seniors that have sent in their senior pictures may be found on the yearbook page. Due to the high volume of submissions, the list may not be updated daily.

-Senior picture submissions **CAN NOT** include filters that change or distort features. Photo submissions MUST be portrait rather than landscape and MUST be focused on face and body. Images that are taken from a distance will need to be replaced.
