

Driven at Heart Scholarship Contest 2024 Application

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Must be a second semester senior.
- 2. Must have participated in a WIAA sanctioned sport during his/her high school career.
- 3. Must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale). Grades earned through the most recently completed grading period should be used.
- 4. Must be involved with civic or community organizations or activities during his/her high school career (grades 9-12).
- 5. Must be available to attend the Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame 74th Anniversary Induction Ceremony on April 20, 2024. If the ceremony does not take place, Cousins Subs, Inc. will coordinate an alternative event for winners and their family at a date and location yet to be determined.
- 6. Must be a college bound student. The educational institution must be accredited, either by the Accrediting Council of Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS), or by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.
- 7. Must consent to be photographed, audio recorded and/or video recorded, and all photographs, audio recordings and video recordings become the property of Cousins Subs, Inc. A Publicity Release Form will be required to be signed by all finalists. If the applicant is under the age of 18, an adult must sign on his/her behalf.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Student must complete an application online at cousinssubs.com/drivenatheart or by mailing in an application available for download at cousinssubs.com/drivenatheart by the deadline of 11:59PM CST February 29, 2024. Mailed applications must be postmarked by February 24, 2024. This will include responses to the following questions:
 - In 250-300 words, explain your involvement in the community and what drives you to give back.
 - In 200 words, describe an athletic moment that taught you an important life lesson and how athletic participation will assist you in future academic and athletic success.
 - Please describe your future career goals.
 - Please indicate any additional information that you believe would be of assistance to the selection committee.
- 2. Student must submit an official copy of transcripts.
- 3. Student must submit two letters of recommendation. First, an athletic endorsement from a school staff member. Second, an endorsement for community work from a community member.
