

**BINGHAM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION  
DIRECTIONS**

1. Scholarship awards range from \$5,000-\$10,000 (depending on the quantity and quality of applications submitted)
2. The selection criteria will include:
  - Academics (you must have a minimum of a 3.0 Grade Point Average)
  - Character
  - Commitment to complete a post-secondary program (Must be public 4-year university in Wisconsin or technical school in Wisconsin)
  - Must demonstrate financial need
3. Your completed application packet must include:
  - Cover sheet (title of scholarship and your name)
  - Personal information page
  - Participation page
  - 5 essays
  - Signature page
  - Three letters of recommendation
  - A letter of acceptance from the post-secondary school you will attend. If you are undecided, attach letters from the schools you are considering.
  - Unofficial transcript (See #4 below)
4. Attach a transcript that includes first semester of your senior year and your current class rank.

**Please submit application packet with cover sheet (Title of the scholarship and student name) and one (1) original application and four (4) copies. Include all recommendations) by April 11, 2024, by 3:00 PM to Ms. Prissel in Student Services.**

1. Write an essay in which you tell the selection committee of your personal qualifications, your school and community activities and accomplishments, and why you are interested in this scholarship. It would be appreciated if you could discuss your financial situation, need for the scholarship, etc.
2. List any courses you have taken which could be considered college preparation or advanced areas of study. Comment on these classes

and tell how you feel they have prepared you for your chosen field or college in general.

3. In evaluating your application, the scholarship committee hopes to gain as complete a picture of you as possible. However, our knowledge of you is limited to the information you provide to us. Please use this page to tell us anything about you that you think we should know regarding your qualification/need for the Bingham Scholarship.
4. In order for the scholarship committee to know your academic and extracurricular interests better, please respond, in essay form, to ONE of the following:
  - A. Describe an intellectual experience of the past two years that has given you great satisfaction.
  - B. Which activity in or out of school is most meaningful to you? Why?
5. If you were given the opportunity to spend a day with any one person, living, deceased or fictional, with whom would you choose and why? Your choice should illustrate to the committee, something about you/your values, the kind of person you are/hope to become.

**IMPORTANT:** Three written recommendations are needed from non-relatives

Note: You may be asked to attend a personal interview with the committee.

Please attach an additional page with any other pertinent information, financial or otherwise, that you would like the scholarship committee to know.
