



Charlie Carpenter Scholarship Guidelines

The Charlie Carpenter Memorial Scholarship provides a \$500 scholarship for a graduating Memorial High School senior who has been active in tech ed during their high school studies. The fund is in memory of Charlie Carpenter, who taught technology education at Memorial High School for many years.

Criteria

Applicant must be a graduating senior from Memorial High School who has been involved in Tech Ed classes.

Selection will be based on:

- Intent to attend a post-secondary institution
- Participation in tech ed classes
- Leadership qualities/community service
- Your essay

Application

To be considered applicants must submit the following to Student Services:

1. A **typed cover page** that includes: name of the scholarship, your name, address, and phone number
2. A **typed letter** requesting that you be considered for the scholarship, the name of post-secondary school you plan to attend, and a list of all scholarships you have received as of the scholarship due date
3. A **typed essay** of 500 words or less describing your involvement in Tech Ed class and any leadership/community service experience you may have, and explain why you believe you are a strong candidate for this scholarship
4. Scholarship application form
5. Recommendation letter
6. A high school transcript
7. Submit your application to the Student Services office by **Friday, February 17, 2025, by 3:00 PM.**
