Purpose

The purpose of The Memorial High School Class of '60 Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance for graduating Eau Claire Memorial High School students continuing on to higher education, as well as contribute a portion of these funds to Memorial's Giving Tree, a Fund to help Memorial High School students in need.

The Fund will award one scholarship annually. Though the amount varies each year, the student that is selected can anticipate receiving a scholarship of approximately \$500. ECCF will issue the scholarship award after the student submits their proof of enrollment. Additional information will be provided to the recipient of the scholarship once it is awarded.

History

Since 2010, members of the Memorial High School Class of 1960 have contributed to this Scholarship Fund to help graduating students at their alma mater.
