Expectations for Students:

- **★** Learn every day
- ★ Check school email and respond in a timely manner
- ★ Access work through Canvas, grades in Skyward
- ★ Turn in work on time
- ★ Participate in Teams meetings/class discussions
- ★ Reach out to school staff when you have questions or do not understand an assignment

Expectations for Parents/Guardians:

- **★** Provide up-to-date contact information for all parents/guardians and emergency contacts, including preferred method of contact: phone or email.

Usernames and Passwords

- Username for students is their student ID number followed by @ecasd.us
 *some apps do not require the @ecasd.us as part of the username, so you may want to try different ways if you cannot get into the account
- Password is their lunch PIN (if you do not know this number, please contact food service)

- Go to the district website <u>www.ecasd.us</u>
- Click on the purple Student Technology Resources Login icon on the right side of page
- Scroll down to Student Email (Office 365) and click
- Enter username and password

Microsoft Teams

- All meeting invites come via e-mail
- Click on "Join Meeting"

Canvas

• Go to the district website www.ecasd.us

- Click on Canvas LMS on the top left of the screen
- Click on the Canvas Student or Canvas Parent icon on the middle right side of the page
- Enter username and password

How to set up a parent/observer account:

- 1. Go to the district website www.ecasd.us
- 2. Click "Canvas LMS" on the blue toolbar
- 3. On the left-hand side of the screen click "How to sign up as a Parent Observer"
- 4. Follow the step by step procedure. In this procedure the student is given a "pairing code" in which the parent uses AFTER the student has logged out.

The parent then complete steps 5-7 using the pairing code they were given.

*If a student is not willing to share their login info with a parent, it's just their email for the login and lunch code for the password which can be obtained through food service or school secretary.

WHAT TO DO WHEN STUDENTS ARE NOT ENGAGING?

Protocols for staff when students are not engaged....

If a student is not engaging in coursework: (A timeline is important so that students can't get too far behind.)

- 1. Teacher emails student AND parent two times, if no response within one day of email
- 2. Teacher calls home to talk with parents. If parents indicate need for other help, referral to school counselor or other staff may be warranted. If no answer, leave a message.
- 3. If after phone call home the student is still not engaged and teacher has not heard back from parent, second call from teacher. Leave another message and email.
- 4. If teacher phone calls don't prompt engagement, call home from school counselor or team member set up by school (see considerations below).
- 5. If no contact can be made, leave a message and send a certified letter.
- 6. If no response to voicemail or email, referral for a welfare check.
