#### Application

To be considered applicants must submit the following to Student Services:

- 1. A **typed cover page** that includes name of the scholarship, your name, address, and phone number
- 2. A **typed letter** requesting that you be considered for the scholarship, the name of postsecondary school you plan to attend, and a list of all scholarships you have received as of the scholarship due date
- 3. A **typed essay** of 500 words or less describing your academic and professional goals along with your involvement in golf and community leadership/service experience, and explain why you believe you are a strong candidate for this scholarship
- 4. Scholarship application form
- 5. At least one recommendation letter
- 6. A high school transcript
- 7. Submit your application to the Student Services office by March 15, 2024, by 3:00 PM.
