including Primary factors (ACT score, GPA, course rigor) and Secondary factors
(leadership roles, service/volunteerism, school/community involvement.

<ul> <li>Currently only UW Madison requires letters of recommendation as part of your</li> </ul>
admission application (1)
□ When to include a letter: If you are a "bubble" student and/or if your admission
is postponed/waitlisted
□ Letter should be from <b>core</b> academic teachers- Please give the teacher a
resume and allow at least a <b>two week</b> notice when asking a teacher for a
recommendation later. Provide a completed "Brag Sheet" for the teacher.
□ Focus of the letter: Your ability to successfully complete college level work.
Universities want to know that you've got what it takes not only to be admitted to
their school, but also to graduate from their school
