

# Stromwall Family Scholarship Fund A Fund of the Eau Claire Community Foundation

## **Purpose**

The purpose of the Stromwall Family Scholarship Fund is to further the education of students of Memorial High School by providing annual scholarships to students who are on track to graduate within one year. Special consideration is given to students with significant financial need. The scholarship award each year is \$1,000. ECCF will issue the scholarship award after the student submits their proof of enrollment. Additional information will be provided to the recipient of the scholarship once it is awarded.

## History

Jack Stromwall and his wife Donna were members of the Eau Claire Community Foundation's Society of Founders. Jack and Donna were strong supporters of students seeking post-secondary education, and this scholarship helps students attain that goal, regardless of their financial circumstances. Though Jack and Donna have now both passed, their legacy of generosity will continue to carry forward and support students in the community.

The application is available for eligible students. Grade point shall not be the determining factor; the need for financial support shall be the factor considered in selecting applicants to receive scholarships. The financial need will be the weighted factor in scoring. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid ("FAFSA") may be used in evaluating applications but is not a determining factor.
