Tips for Winning Scholarships

- ✓ Do not wait until May of your senior year to start applying for scholarships.
- ✓ Choose references that will say good things about you and give them at least two to three weeks to write a letter of recommendation for you. Brag sheets are available in Student Services.
- ✓ ALWAYS include your transcripts and AT LEAST one letter of recommendation with your application. They can separate you from your peers.
- ✓ Transcripts can be requested through *Parchment* and are free of charge.
- ✓ Be very neat and follow directions. When possible, always type.
- ✓ Follow deadlines. Applications submitted after deadlines (dates and/or times) will not be accepted.
- ✓ On a scholarship resume, MORE IS BETTER. Be sure to include everything you have done since ninth grade (ex. activities, work, leadership)
- ✓ Never pay for scholarship information.

Scholarships for Southeast Asian High School Seniors

Sponsored by the Nisei Student Relocation Commemorative Fund, a national scholarship program created by second generation Japanese Americans (Nisei) who were interned during World War II. As high school and college students, their incarceration abruptly halted their schooling. With the help of the National Japanese American Student Relocation Council, these students were able to leave the concentration camps and complete their college educations.

In 1980 the Nisei established this scholarship fund to honor those who helped them by "paying it forward." The scholarships are awarded annually to Southeast Asian high school seniors throughout the U.S. It is an opportunity to support students' post-secondary aspirations.

To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria: be Southeast Asian or have at least one parent of Southeast Asian descent, be a Wisconsin resident, have a GPA of at least 2.5 or higher from the fall 2023-2024 semester or most recent transcript.

First Generation College Student

This scholarship is focused on our first-generation Southeast Asian students who are currently a high school senior to graduate level student. We define first-generation college students as meaning **your parent(s) did not complete a 4-year college or university degree, regardless of other family member's level of education.** We hope that providing this scholarship will support and encourage more first-generation Southeast Asian students to pursue higher education and reduce/lessen financial barriers to being the first.

The Andrew Cray Higher Education Fund was founded in memory of Andy, a 2004 Chi Hi alumni, in 2016. A transgender man who transitioned during college, he found his calling as an advocate in Washington D.C. for the LGBTQ+ community, where he fought healthcare discrimination based on gender identity and sexual orientation until his death of cancer in 2014 at the age of 28. Andy was posthumously given the award of "Champion of Change" by President Barack Obama. The scholarship fund in his honor was started in October 2016 by his family, with the first scholarship awarded the following May. The goal of the HEF is to assist LGBTQ+ youth in receiving secondary education to help them achieve greatness, follow their dreams, and help this world become more accepting of all its children, just as Andy's work did.
