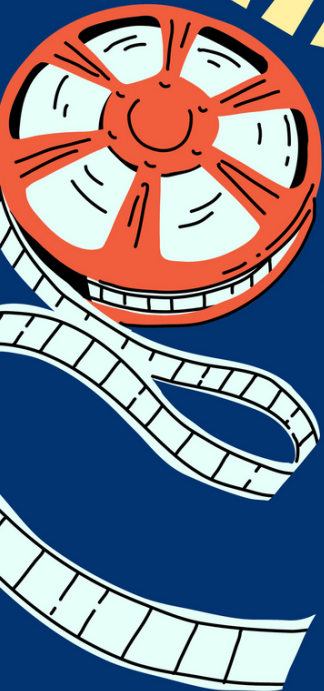

If either of these are incorrect, please stop by the North High School Registrar's office with a copy of your birth certificate so your permanent records can be updated. Diplomas will be ordered March 18, 2024. After this date, any corrections made will be the student's responsibility, including contacting Jostens directly and paying for any cost incurred.
