All juniors will take the ACT Plus Writing, free of charge, at North High School during the school day on Wednesday, February 20, 2019 and take the ACT Work Keys on Thursday, February 21, 2019. No registration is required for either assessment on these dates as the registration procedures will be completed by the school. The ACT is offered at multiple times during the school year and students can take it more than once but the February 20, 2019 assessment at school is the only one that is free of charge to all district juniors.

Dalton Banks Celebrates Two Major Milestones

Eau Claire North High School is proud to recognize Dalton Banks for two major milestone accomplishments. On Friday, December 11th, at Eau Claire Memorial, he became the 3rd Husky in school history to surpass 1,000 career points. On Monday, December 14th, at Wausau West, Dalton became North High School's all-time leading scorer for the boy's basketball program, surpassing former record holder Tyler Brown from the class of 2009. North High School is extremely proud of its rich tradition in boys' basketball and Dalton has now stamped his legacy in the record books. Congratulations, Dalton!



John and JoAnne Evans Receive Distinguished Service Award

Lifelong fans of the Huskies, John & JoAnne Evans raised 3 children, all who graduated from North High School – Jack in 1999, Nick in 2001, and Susie in 2002. In 1997 John & JoAnne were elected Husky Athletics Booster Club Co-presidents.

JoAnne resigned in 1998 when she was elected to the Eau Claire School Board. While on the board, JoAnne was a strong advocate for student athletic programs. She also worked to pass a referendum that included building the North High School track & field, baseball, and softball complex, along with major repairs to the tennis courts.

John Evans served as the North High School and Husky Athletics Booster Club president from 1997-2000. During that time, the booster club raised more than \$150,000 which was given back to the school to help purchase new track & field equipment; a new timing system for the pool, new weight room equipment, and renovations to the Doghouse, among many other things.

As Booster Club President, John also reinstated the Homecoming Parade. John founded the Husky Hall of Fame. He has served on the committee for 20 years and was inducted into the Husky Athletics Hall of Fame in 2008.

The Evans' support of the Huskies continues today. John & JoAnne are Major Sponsors of the North Golf Outing and the Husky Fest each year. The generosity and support they have provided for the Husky Fest is one of the reasons for the event's success. John has worked to preserve the history of Husky Athletics and its student-athletes, including various displays of plaques that reflect North's rich athletic history.

Public School Open Enrollment: Feb. 4 - April 30, 2019

Wisconsin residents in grades 4K-12 may apply to attend school in a school district other than the one in which they live. For example: a child who lives in the Altoona School District could apply to attend the Eau Claire Area School District (ECASD). Students in pre-kindergarten may participate in limited circumstances; parents should call Karen Larson at 852-3003 to find out if their preschool-aged child(ren) qualify.

Students who are currently attending the ECASD through open enrollment DO NOT need to reapply.

The open enrollment application for the 2019-20 school year is February 4 – April 30, 2019. An online application will be available to the public beginning Monday, February 4, and closing at 4:00 pm on April 30, 2019. The spelling of the names is taken directly from the student's record in Skyward. Please check your student's name in Skyward to confirm that the spelling is correct. Also, confirm that it is their legal name. If either of these are incorrect, please stop by the North High School Registrar's office with a copy of your birth certificate so your permanent records can be updated. Diplomas will be ordered in March. After this date, any corrections made will be the student's responsibility, including contacting Jostens directly and paying for any cost incurred.

If you are interested in supporting students and teachers as a paraprofessional, either as a general school aide or a Special Education Aide, you must be 18, have a high school diploma, and complete the EDUStaff application, and attend an EDUStaff training. In the case of Special Education Aides, you must apply for an SEA license (the cost of which will be reimbursed after you sub in the district 5 times).
