

SENIOR PRIVILEGE CONTRACT

We have read and understand the explanation of the Senior Privilege Program. We are aware that should our student be granted such privilege; they may elect to use their time normally spent in assigned study halls as off campus free time. We also understand that by giving our consent for our student to participate in this program, we relieve the school of all responsibility for our child's actions during any unscheduled hour spent off campus. This does not relieve us of any parental responsibility.

We understand that should our child violate the rules or regulations of North High School, this privilege will be revoked, and they will be reassigned to a structured study hall and may not be allowed to leave school grounds, except during lunch. Applications that have been denied will be reviewed quarterly upon student/parent request. If our child experiences attendance issues after this change, the district's truancy process may be initiated.

SENIOR PRIVILEGE PROGRAM

The Senior Privilege Program is available to seniors at North High School. Each senior is allowed one hour of release time in addition to the lunch hour. This is in compliance with WI Statute 118.33 7(a). This program allows for a senior student who has demonstrated a high level of maturity and personal responsibility, to leave the school premises for one period a day. To keep this privilege, a student must remain in good standing at North High.

PURPOSES OF THE SENIOR PRIVILEGE PROGRAM

1. Provide an opportunity for student self-discipline.
2. Give the student the responsibility of utilizing their time wisely.
3. Free the student to work on independent study or volunteer work.
4. Provide an incentive for sophomores and juniors so that they may qualify for the honor when they become seniors.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Each student must have.....

1. earned the honor PRIOR to the end of their junior year. The next opportunity for earning this SPP will be the end of the first quarter, of their senior year, and every nine weeks thereafter.
2. accumulated 15 credits toward graduation by the end of their junior year, and 19 credits must be accumulated after 7 semesters.
3. passed **all** courses taken during the semester preceding the semester for which the application applies.
4. the written consent of a parent or guardian.
5. no obligations to the school. This includes any unserved detentions, **fines**, fees which are delinquent, and any unreturned school property. It is the responsibility of the applicant to clear ALL obligations.
6. their student ID with them at all times for identification and authorization to leave the campus.
7. no record of habitual truancy or excessive excused absences(10 or more per year) at North High.

REVOCATION OF SPP COULD RESULT FROM:

1. Failure to meet qualification requirements.
2. Failure to maintain passing grades in all subjects.
3. Violation of school rules. (Truancy-Skipping)
4. Obligations to the school such as library fines, detentions, etc.
5. A written complaint (including a police or citizen's report) while off campus during school hours.
6. Inappropriate/disruptive behavior in the school, parking lot, or on school grounds.
7. All suspensions or revocations will be made by an administrator and the student will be reassigned to a regular study hall, and not allowed to leave school grounds.
8. Students failing to stay in designated areas such as the computer labs, IMC, designated area in the commons behind the counters, or working in a classroom with a teacher's permission. **Wandering the halls is not permitted.**

Parent or guardian may at any time revoke their approval for this program by mailing a note to that effect or personally contacting the North High School Attendance Office.
