Reminders from Administration

As we approach the end of the school year, please make sure your student is staying on track. Encourage them to get all of their assignments in and to attend all of their classes. If you have any questions regarding summer school please have your student set up a time to meet with their counselor.

Parents please know that the front office is short on staff. If you are calling in, please leave a voicemail and someone will get back to you regarding attendance or any questions you may have. We appreciate your patience during this busy, end of the school year time.

Obtaining a Work Permit - Changes

The Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division has developed a new online work permit application tool. The online application is available to the parents of minors 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from any computer, tablet, smartphone, or similar device. The application is live now. A parent can access the site <u>using these instructions</u>. Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit card or by ACH direct withdrawal. Once the permit application process is complete, the Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer.

Beginning June 7th, you will no longer be able to obtain a work permit at North High School and you must use the online system described above.

Selective Service Registration

All men must register with the Selective Service when they turn 18. By registering on time, males stay eligible for opportunities like student loans, job training, government employment, and U.S. citizenship for immigrants wishing to become citizens. The Selective Service System now also offers online registration. When students register online at www.sss.gov, they receive their Selective Service number instantly. This process can take up to 90 days when done with paper registration. For the many young men who failed to register and were denied financial aid, enrollment eligibility for federal job training programs and Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC), or federal employment because of their failure to register, online registration enables them to regain eligibility quickly.







Yearbook Delivery - May 22
