Step 1

Find a piece of white paper. It is okay if there is something printed on the back. Find some colored paper like junk mail, old magazines (check with your families first) or even wrapping paper. If you don't have that, color a few sheets of paper with different colors.



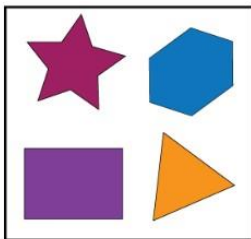
Step 2

Locate a scissors and glue. If you don't have those at home don't worry, you can tear your paper shapes and just arrange the shapes onto the white paper.



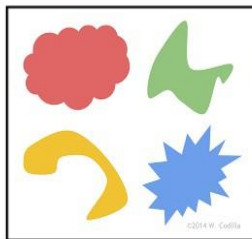
Step 3

Cut out shapes organic, geometric or both and arrange them in an interesting way.

Nature shapes- free
form
