Segmenting Phonemes

Adult can say, "Listen to my word." Then child can tell the sounds he/she hears

shout	sh-ou-t
shape	sh-a-p
chest	ch-e-s-t
then	th-e-n
chin	ch-i-n
thud	th-u-d
shirt	sh-ir-t
shed	sh-e-d
that	th-a-t
chose	ch-o-z

Adding Phonemes

Adult can say, "Say -at. Add /ch/ at the beginning and the word is ____?"

Word	Add	Response
-at	/ch/	chat
-elf	/sh/	shelf
-in	/th/	thin
-ift	/sh/	shift
-an	/th/	than

Deleting Phonemes

Adult can say, "Say chance without /ch/" and child says, "ance"

Word	Without	Response
chance	/ch/	ance
thump	/th/	ump
shock	/sh/	ock
chunk	/ch/	unk
thus	/th/	us

Substituting Phonemes

Adult can say, "Say chop. Change /ch/ to /sh/ and the word is ____."

Word	Change to	Response
chop	/sh/	shop
pin	/ch/	chin
then	/wh/	when
chip	/sh/	ship
chat	/th/	that

- Mix and Fix- cut apart sight word, mix up the letters and fix
