FOCUS ON RESULTS

Mandy Van Vleet, Executive Director of Academic Services, presented information on how ECASD is implementing Equitable Multi-Level System of Supports (EMLSS) and Strategic Plan Priorities across the District, with a specific focus at the elementary and middle school levels. ELA and Math data and goals for grades 3-8 were shared, as well as the framework to help improve instruction in all classrooms, which includes guaranteed and viable curriculum, professional learning, and instructional delivery. Principal Adam Keeton shared how EMLSS is being implemented at Manz Elementary, and Principal Trevor Kohlhepp and two instructional coaches shared how EMLSS is being implemented at South Middle School. Discussion and questions followed.

BOARD DEVELOPMENT

The Board discussed what "reasonable" vs. "unreasonable" means and considerations on how to request agenda items. Commissioner Farrar volunteered to draft policy language that offers the Board and future Boards clarification and structure of expectations and procedures when conflicts, disagreements, and/or other issues arise. Understanding of our current policies was also addressed to utilize them effectively.

Kim Koller, Executive Director of Administration, presented the policy and process that was followed by the ECASD Facilities Naming Committee regarding the following recommendations: 1) Rename 500 Main Street to Marvin G. Lansing Administration Building, 2) Rename the main entrance of North High School the John Bowman Entrance, 3) Rename the athletic field within the track at Memorial High School the Connie and Pat Ulrich Memorial Field, and 4) Rename the athletic field within the track at North High School the Connie and Pat Ulrich North Field. Discussion and questions followed. President Nordin asked that recommendations be reexamined at a future Board meeting under the new Neola policy.
