MONITORING DISTRICT RESULTS

Mandy Van Vleet, Executive Director of Teaching and Learning, presented the monitoring report for R-4 Citizens of a Diverse Community, sharing what is new in the report and areas for growth. The need for additional indicators to accurately measure progress was emphasized, as was the development of the ECASD Learner Profile to address essential competencies and community readiness for students.

Michelle Wiberg, DeLong Middle School Principal, discussed proactive strategies to improve the school environment, including the implementation of PBIS systems, professional learning opportunities, and the integration of social-emotional learning at all levels. The importance of changing adult practices and creating a supportive learning environment was highlighted. Dave Oldenberg, Memorial High School Principal, shared examples of reactive support strategies at the high school level, such as ELT time, the check-in check-out program, conduct reporting, and partnerships with community organizations for mental health services. These supports aim to address students' academic and social-emotional needs. Luke Stordahl, Northwoods Elementary Principal, explained how the school uses student climate survey data to inform school improvement planning. The importance of active supervision and co-regulation in addressing students' needs and improving their interactions with each other was accentuated. External factors like social media and societal attitudes are recognized as contributing challenges. Discussion and questions followed.
