• Update LEAP Zone Process (Coherence Governance) – Jim Schmitt

- Coherent Governance says the superintendent has more decision-making authority with benchmarks laid out by the Board of Education. This means that Step 1.4 (presenting to the school board) is no longer required. Instead, LEAP would present to the Executive Team or designees.
 - i. After speaking with the Superintendent, the language will be updated to change School Board to Superintendent.
