The Homeless Program and Foster Care Program Coordinator provides supports and services for all ECASD students and families who have experienced homelessness or are involved in foster care placement, along with coordinating the ECASD Closet and ECASD Weekend Kids Meals Program.

- Responsibilities include:
 - Coordinating services and items for students experiencing homelessness, providing family support, and connecting with staff and the community to advocate for resources.
 - Coordinating services for students who have been placed in a foster care setting, and connecting with staff, family, and community stakeholders to coordinate efforts.
 - Coordinating the ECASD Closet volunteers, donations, and usage by district staff.
 - o Coordinating the ECASD Weekend Kids Meals program.

 - o American Indian Education Title VI Program
 - Connects with high school students to assess their needs and provide academic, emotional, and essential living supports.
 - Coordinates culturally relevant events and opportunities for K-12 American Indian students
 - Provides parents and students knowledge of resources available for furthering education, community and government assistance programs, and basic tribal programs and enrollment

The School and Community Liaison works within the Student Services team to direct services to students and families, work with individuals or small groups, and act as a liaison for families with school and community.

- Responsibilities include:
 - Serves as an advocate for students and families
 - Assists staff with identifying and obtaining relevant information for evaluation and assessment of students' academic skills, concerns, or needs, and help with facilitating the process with families, if needed
 - Meets with students individually to support their academic and social emotional needs
 - Provides culturally relevant resources and support for staff and community to meet the needs of Hmong and Hispanic students and their families
 - Assists district and schools with promoting cultural bridges between district, schools, students, and families

Creates opportunities for students and families to learn about resources and support that are available in the schools and the community and to access those resources and supports
