



# Parent Canvas Accounts

1. Go to <https://www.ecasd.us/Start-Pages> and click on **Canvas LMS**.
2. Touch **Parent/Guardian of an ECASD Student**.
3. If you don't have an account, in the top of the dialogue box that pops up, click on **Parent of a Canvas User? Click Here For an Account**. If have an account, sign in.
4. Fill in our information. For the student pairing code, email your teacher to obtain a one use code. You may want to do this before starting this process so you have it on hand. Click **Start Participating**.

5. Once you are in the account, you can see all the classes your student is in. Some things such as quizzes and discussions are unable to be viewed. If you click on grades on the right side of the screen inside of a class, you can view which assignments have been completed and graded. You should be able to click on the assignments to view your student's work.
6. I strongly recommend the free Canvas Parent app in either the Google Play or Apple's App Stores. It's easy to use and looks nice. I don't know what creating an account looks like in the app, but I'm sure it's possible. Otherwise, just create it in a browser with the directions above and sign in on the app.
