## **Suggested Daily Academics:**

### Options Include:

- Lesson Checks—these are completed on the iPad. This includes a review of skills that have been already taught. Lesson checks also allow you to check your answers and display step-by-step directions if needed. Only complete Lesson Checks from Units 1-5, and Unit 8 Lessons 1-9.
- Fluency Practice—these are completed on the iPad, but students may need paper to perform the calculations. They review multi-digit multiplication.

- Students can keep a daily journal in a notebook where they write about their day or anything else that is on their mind.
