Blending & Segmenting:
Surprise Bag-Find a bag
or box that is not
see-through. Place
drawings or actual
objects in the bag (can be
anything with 3-4 sounds
in the word): cup, spoon,
cap, ten, pin. Reach into
the container and say the
word in segments (c-u-p)
your child should guess
the object before you
reveal. Continue with the
rest. Once all are out of
the bag, your child should
choose one at a time to
segment before putting
them back.
