K-5

Draw and create a weekly journal using pictures showing how you are feeling each day. Include in your pictures how you spent your day in learning and in play. Your journal can be pencil drawings or drawn and then colored. Feel free to add the date and a few sentences to go with your daily journal drawings.

2-5

Use your empty toilet paper or paper towel tubes to create Art!

1. Toilet paper tubes make excellent stamps. They are flexible so bend them to make a variety of shapes. Dip them in paint and create a stamping design. After your stamp designs have dried, add additional design and color using markers or crayons.
