- to encourage the pursuit of mathematics related careers
- to recognize student achievement in mathematics
- The MATHCOUNTS program provides materials with an emphasis on problem solving and critical thinking skills for classroom use as well as a series of regional, state, and national competitions. The competitions begin with the regional competition in February. Each participating school enters a team of four students.

To prepare the students for selection to our school team, we will meet with all interested students once per week outside of class. All students will have a chance to go to our local meets, and twelve students will represent South at our Regional Meet at Delong (Thursday, Feb. 2).

The coaching practice sessions will be held on Thursdays beginning November 2. Thursday sessions will meet in the morning 6:50-7:20 AM (use Door 1) and/or the afternoon from 3:003:30 PM. in Mr. Mueller's Room in the $8^{\text {th }}$ grade house (220C).
