- o Came up with two scenarios, one with Roosevelt and one without Roosevelt

 - o Kim has been with the District for a long time and is currently the Putnam Heights Elementary School Principal
 - She will be taking over the Executive Director of Administration position and will be the lead Resource Member for the Demo & Trends Committee
- Introduced committee members

Discussion Conversation

- o The workgroup provided relief for north side and absorption of Roosevelt
- o There is a possibility we may be moving kid's middle schools by making these changes
 - o Do we keep the middle schools the same or do the kids follow the school?
 - Shifting north of 312 will change middle school from DeLong to Northstar
- o North of 312
 - Were originally anticipating moving it to Sherman, but implemented flexible boundaries at the time of Roosevelt Referendum discussion
 - Now looking to move it to Sam Davey
- Airport Area
 - o Currently Sam Davey thinking to straighten Locust Lane boundary
 - Moving Princeton Valley as well
- o Chunk below 312 from Locust Lane to Northwoods
- Finger from Sam Davey to Longfellow
- Talked about APL study for north side
 - We are averaging the capacity across the District
- We would need to have multiple options for the Spanish immersion options included
 - o Board has had listening sessions
 - o Something may come in June
- o We aren't hurting Longfellow to leave 3rd ward out for immersion
- Kids in the finger may need to change middle schools at some point
- o Doing this on current population not what is in 2 years
- o Moving 3rd ward past 2 other schools to get them to Longfellow seems strange
- o All of this work does very little to handle the southside
- Part of this may be absorbing Roosevelt and using that money to build on the south side
- o South side problem is new space
 - Easy for us to recommend adding onto a building
 - o Moving boundaries doesn't solve the issues
 - Made Putnam with 4-section in mind
 - This is the problem with Roosevelt didn't anticipate future needs
- o Northside is something we can work on now
 - o Are we still up in the air about Prairie Ridge?
 - Was put on hold due to government
 - Something new is coming, but not for a couple years
 - o Little Red
 - Hasn't had people in it for 10 + years
- Construction costs are growing
 - o Last year would have said 5% increase
 - o Now thinking 10% increase

- o Supplies are in a high demand
- o Oil is over \$80
 - 1 year ago, it was \$45
 - Labor is going up as well
- The Board had multiple questions about Roosevelt
 - o How many times has the Board talked about it
 - Board said to wait for Roosevelt for later \$19M
 - How many times has Demo & Trends talked about it
 - Demo said to build a new in same location
 - o Official rescind recommendation came to Board in May 17, 2018
 - Stated group were focused on Roosevelt
 - Group never said that there was 90+ capacity issue on the south side
 - At the time group stated if Roosevelt stays open it needs work
- Wild cards
 - o Spanish Immersion
 - o Prairie Ridge
 - Was 4K in the elementary buildings before
 - Was only in north side schools
 - o Longfellow, Locust Lane, North High
- o Lasalle Street may be getting more houses soon
- o Cannery District downtown may have a pocket neighborhood starting
- o Golf course may be developed at some point in the future
- Don't refer to Princeton Valley are as a whole there is only a specific few streets that are that location
- o It would be nice to have a City Planner on the committee
 - o Josh met with an Eau Claire planner
 - o Caro will ask a city planner to come in
- Look at Absorb map
 - o Section 1 same as relief
 - Section 2 airport land
 - there is a subdivision in the area Hallie Ridge
 - o Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 same
 - o Section 8 finger to Northwoods
 - o Section 9 Dells Pond to Northwoods
 - o Section 10 to Longfellow
 - o Section 11 to Longfellow
 - o Section 12, 13, 15 to Sherman
 - o Section 14, 16, 17 to Lakeshore
- o Blocks are easier to send to the same school
- o Goal is to not change HS boundaries
- o Should try to move section #15 to Lakeshore instead of Sherman
- o Can change lines to help north side
- o South side we actually have to add on
- o Someone is always going to be upset
 - o There will be 1 bad thing that will cover all the good
 - o 3rd ward will help to create equity
 - o All schools are good
- o 3rd ward is its own little area
 - o Thought originally were supposed to go to Flynn
 - o Then put to Lakeshore and DeLong
- o Everyone is going to have to give and take
- o For tax payers we are doing economically the best we can for the best results

- o Good idea to add on in spaces that are needing space instead of northside schools
- o We need a better handle on Prairie Ridge
 - o Would be nice to know
- South side building isn't fast
 - o We have a debt drop in 2021
 - Keeping the levy flat is top goal
 - We don't have a lot of debt for a big district
 - o We are realistically looking at 2021 or 2022 for building
- o Try to be proactive not reactive
- o Lots of things are important, but getting people to pay is a difficult task
- o What is our long-term plan?
- o Do we use all of the Admin Building?
 - o No
 - o Could the Administration Building use Roosevelt?
 - Roosevelt is 40,000 sq. feet
 - 62,000 sq. feet are being utilized at current location
 - ~\$1.10/sq. foot for electricity
- o South is going to need an upgrade
- o Monday when we go through timeline
 - o Add in most fiscally responsibility for District is to make space on the south side
 - o Makes more sense to utilize current space
- o 2021 debt drop off
 - Want to be incurring debt when it is going to drop off
 - Need a referendum/plan in place
 - Look at how much goes off and interest rates
 - What amount can you finance with what is dropping off
 - o Roosevelt has been coming up a lot
- o We will have new Board members in June
- o Keep Board up to date on Prairie Ridge, South Side, and Spanish Immersion
