ELEMENTARY VIRTUAL CONNECTION

Fully Virtual Option Available for Fall 2021

Many of our students and families in the Cohort C learning model have expressed a desire to continue with fully virtual learning beyond the current school year. If this is the case for you, we have good news to share!

There is NO CAP on enrollment for Eau Claire Virtual School for the 2021-22 school year. Students and families are asked to submit their applications by July 1 to enroll for this fall. ECVS is open to students who attend the Eau Claire Area School District, as well as those from throughout the Chippewa Valley and across the state.

Students in Grades 6-12 will use Pearson curriculum taught by certified Pearson teachers. Students in Grades 4-5 will use Pearson curriculum taught by ECASD teachers. Kindergarten-Grade 3 students will use ECASD curriculum taught by ECASD teachers, similar to what our cohort C students experienced this school year in our 100% virtual learning model.
