## 2. TOPIC OF EVENING:

- Superintendent Update
  - The district is preparing for the possibility of having to switch to virtual school in the case of staffing concerns. Present data and procedures regarding absences were reviewed.
  - The district continues to maintain weekly communication with the Eau Claire County Health Department.
- Test to Stay Program with Dr. Kaying Xiong
  - Reviewed Test to Stay Program
    - Eligibility- Individual does not have symptoms, unvaccinated, close COVID contact occurred outside of the home, and the individual is able to wear a mask appropriately.
    - Students/Staff in the Test to Stay Program would test daily at school.
    - Barriers- The Test to Stay Program is currently on hold due to lack of antigen tests.
- Gateway Program with Mandy Van Vleet, Brenda Swoboda, and Kelsey Tichey
  - Reviewed community-based transition options at the Eastridge Center
    - Two programs are currently being offered through the Eastridge Center (Gateway and Life without Limits)
    - The current programs serve students receiving special education services aged 18-21 years old.
    - The programs focus on improving post-secondary outcomes.
