1. News from the schools

- a. Roosevelt has raised over \$14,000 to support new playground equipment.

2. TOPIC OF EVENING:

- a. Superintendent Update
 - i. The district is preparing for the possibility of having to switch to virtual school in the case of staffing concerns. Present data and procedures regarding absences were reviewed.
 - ii. The district continues to maintain weekly communication with the Eau Claire County Health Department.
- b. Test to Stay Program with Dr. Kaying Xiong
 - i. Reviewed Test to Stay Program
 - 1. Eligibility- Individual does not have symptoms, unvaccinated, close COVID contact occurred outside of the home, and the individual is able to wear a mask appropriately.
 - 2. Students/Staff in the Test to Stay Program would test daily at school.
 - 3. Barriers- The Test to Stay Program is currently on hold due to lack of antigen tests.
- c. Gateway Program with Mandy Van Vleet, Brenda Swoboda, and Kelsey Tichey
 - i. Reviewed community-based transition options at the Eastridge Center
 - 1. Two programs are currently being offered through the Eastridge Center (Gateway and Life without Limits)
 - 2. The current programs serve students receiving special education services aged 18-21 years old.
 - 3. The programs focus on improving post-secondary outcomes.
