Message from the Principal

Dear Virtual Families,

With the latest decision for middle school (April 26) and high school (May 3) Cohort A and B students to attend in-person learning four days a week there will be some building schedule changes that will occur. Due to the number of staff who teach to all three Cohorts this may impact your Cohort C student’s schedule.

The middle schools will be keeping the same schedule for core classes. The encore classes will be taught asynchronously for the most part with teachers developing some opportunities for synchronous learning possibly on Wednesdays. Please pay attention to communication from your child’s home school as this transition occurs.

The high schools are looking at shortening periods 1-5 to allow for time in the afternoon for electives taught 100% virtually (music, PE, world languages, business, etc) to meet face-to-face with their students for Cohort A and B. Some departments may also be utilizing Wednesdays as a day to meet synchronously with students. In order to eliminate scheduling conflicts, Cohort C high school students will follow the new bell schedule that has been created (see below). Some of your student’s core teachers who do not have scheduling conflicts with their Cohort A/B students may elect to have synchronous times with their Cohort C students four days a week. We understand this may cause scheduling conflicts for some students. Teachers will be recording lessons if students are unavailable to meet during the newly scheduled class times. The source of truth for your student’s new meeting times starting May 3rd will be communicated by the teacher and through Canvas.

Schedule for Virtual Pick-up Materials

Delong Material Pick-Up:

Cohort C students will be able to pick up materials on these dates: April 29, May 13 and May 27 from 7:00am to 4:30pm at door 1. Teachers will inform their students if they have materials to pick up. Items will be bagged and/or clearly marked with the student name in the door 1 lobby. Cohort C families may drop off library books and textbooks on material pick up days. These should be placed in the labeled bins.

Northstar Material Pick-Up:

Cohort C students will be able to pick up materials on these dates: April 29, May 13 and May 27 from 7:00am to 4:30pm at door 1. Teachers will inform their students if they have materials to pick up. Items will be bagged and/or clearly marked with the student name on tables within the door 1 lobby. Cohort C families may drop off library books and textbooks on materials pick up days. These should be placed in the labeled bins.

South Material Pick-Up:

Cohort C students will be able to pick up materials on these dates: April 29, May 13 and May 27 from 7:00am to 4:30pm at door 1. Teachers will inform their students if they have materials to pick up. Fully Virtual Option Available for Fall 2021

Many of our students and families in the Cohort C learning model have expressed a desire to continue with fully virtual learning beyond the current school year. If this is the case for you, we have good news to share!

There is NO CAP on enrollment for Eau Claire Virtual School for the 2021-22 school year. Students and families are asked to submit their applications by July 1 to enroll for this fall. ECVS is open to students who attend the Eau Claire Area School District, as well as those from throughout the Chippewa Valley and across the state.

Students in Grades 6-12 will use Pearson curriculum taught by certified Pearson teachers. Students in Grades 4-5 will use Pearson curriculum taught by ECASD teachers. Kindergarten-Grade 3 students will use ECASD curriculum taught by ECASD teachers, much like they may have experienced this school year in our 100% virtual learning model.
