These next questions are about bullying and cyberbullying. Bullying happens when one or more students tease, threaten, spread rumors about, hit, shove or hurt another student. It is not bullying when students of about the same strength or power argue or fight or tease each other in a friendly way. Bullies are usually stronger, or have more friends or more money, or some other power over the student being bullied. Usually, bullying happens over and over, or the student being bullied thinks it might happen over and over. Cyberbullying is bullying that takes place using electronic technology.

These next questions are about drugs and alcohol. Drugs means any substance, including those used to get "high" or increase performance in school or sports, other than alcohol or tobacco. Examples include marijuana, illegal drugs, inhalants, synthetic drugs used to get high (K-2, bath salts, white lightning), or over-the counter medicine. This does not include medications prescribed by a doctor or nurse for the person but includes prescription drugs that are NOT prescribed to the person by their doctor.

"Alcohol" means a full or part of a drink or alcohol. Examples include beer, wine, mixed drink, shot of liquor, or any combination of those alcoholic drinks. This does not include alcohol that you may drink for religious purposes.
