- Apply at website or by calling customer service at **(800) 867-7183**
(Note: online applications can be processed and approved within in 7-10 business days. Customer service phone applications are processed within 12-30 business days)
- Includes new smartphone, 350 minutes/month, unlimited texting and some data
- Families can qualify in one of two ways-enrollment in a government program (i.e. SSI, Medicaid, Food Stamps, Public Housing, etc.) or if household is below a certain income level based on number of people in the home (i.e. a 3-person household cannot exceed \$28,829/year income)
- Income verification or a photocopy of proof of enrollment in a government program is required to apply
- Families need to complete a "recertification" process once year (to confirm continued need) and make at least one call per month to keep the phone
- There can only be one Lifeline cell phone per household

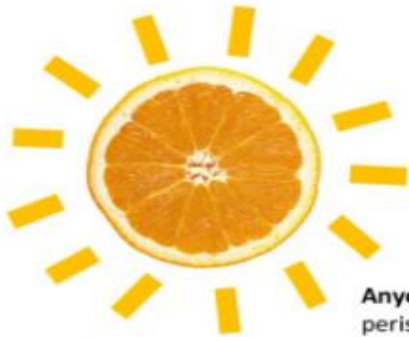
