Fully Virtual Option Available for Fall 2021

Many of our students and families in the Cohort C learning model have expressed a desire to continue with fully virtual learning beyond the current school year. If this is the case for you, we have good news to share!

Starting in fall 2021, there will be NO CAP on enrollment for our [Eau Claire Virtual School](#). As a result, any student who applies to ECVS before July 1 will be guaranteed enrollment in the school. ECVS is open to students who attend the Eau Claire Area School District, as well as those from throughout the Chippewa Valley and across the state.

ECVS was launched in fall 2019—before anyone had ever heard of COVID-19. It has been a big success, providing an innovative educational path that allows for the creative blend of opportunities to continually build the strengths of each learner. The school strives to provide high-quality, relevant, and enriching learning experiences to develop engaged, passionate learners who are confident in their abilities and able to retain and apply developed skills.
