Schedule for Virtual Pick-up Materials

Delong Material Pick-Up:

Items will be bagged and/or clearly marked with the student name in the door 1 lobby. Cohort C families may drop off library books and textbooks on material pick up days. These should be placed in the labeled bins.

Northstar Material Pick-Up:

Cohort C students will be able to pick up materials on these dates: May 13 and May 27 from 7:00am to 4:30pm at door 1. Teachers will inform their students if they have materials to pick up. Items will be bagged and/or clearly marked with the student name on tables within the door 1 lobby. Cohort C families may drop off library books and textbooks on materials pick up days. These should be placed in the labeled bins.

South Material Pick-Up:

Cohort C students will be able to pick up materials on these dates: May 13 and May 27 from 7:00am to 4:30pm at door 1. Teachers will inform their students if they have materials to pick up.
