PARKING PERMITS

Parking permits are available for purchase from the business office beginning Friday, September 3rd from 7:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. The permit's non-refundable cost for the school year is \$50, Please bring your completed application, driver's license, cash, or check made out to MHS, and slip from library indicating you have no library fines. Student Drop Off and Pick Up

WORK PERMIT INFORMATION

Work permits are required for every new job a student has until they turn 16. The Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division has developed a new online work permit application tool. The application is live now. A parent can access the site using these instructions. Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit card or by ACH direct withdrawal.


Memorial Highlights
