## Class of 2025 - Need to Know Information

### **Graduation Requirements:**

Every student must earn 23.5 credits to qualify for a diploma from Memorial High School. Students must earn 13.50 credits in required courses and must also earn 7 credits in electives. The following credits are required:

English	4 Credits
Mathematics	3 Credits
Science	3 Credits
Social Studies	3 Credits
Health	.5 Credits
Phy. Ed	1.5 Credits
Electives	8.5 Credits

### **Letters of Recommendation:**

Some students may need to include letters of recommendation when applying to selective colleges/universities and also when applying for scholarships. Student **MUST GIVE THE RECOMMENDERS A MINIMUM OF THREE WEEKS NOTICE.** When students have January 1<sup>st</sup> deadlines, students must request recommendations no later than December 1<sup>st</sup>. School counselors **will not** be responsible for meeting deadlines if late requests are made.
