WHATS GOING ON IN STUDENT SERVICES?

Students who are currently taking AP Macroeconomics and are interested in taking the AP exam for AP Macroeconomics have until March 1st to register. Registration will need to be through MySchoolBucks or a paper registration form can be picked up in Student Services. The exam costs \$100 and is free to students who qualify for Free/Reduced lunch.
